## Example of lesson plan (CLT approach)

**Lesson Plan** 

1. **Topic** : Talking about Personality

2. **Students' Grade** : Grade IX of Junior High School

3. **Skills** : Speaking, Writing, Reading, and Listening

4. **Time** : 50 minutes

- 5. **Objectives/aims:**
- Students are expected to be able to talk about their own personality, family, friends, ...
- Students are expected to be able to express how to ask and speak about personality.
- 6. **Method** : Communicative Language Teaching approach
- 7. **Teaching resources**: Handbooks and Prospect 3
- 8. **Steps of activities** :(pre, whilst/while, post)
  - a. Pre-activity: (15 minutes)
- Students are given a piece of paper. (2 minutes)
- Students are asked to write any adjectives related to personality. (the teacher can help them) (3 minutes)
- Students exchange their paper to their partner. (2 minutes)
- Some students are asked to read their vocabularies (personality). (8minutes)
  - b. Whilst/while: (30 minutes)
- Students are asked to listen the conversation then they answer the teacher's questions. (3 minutes)
- Students are asked to make a group of three and talking about their personality.
- (5 minutes)
- Students are asked to identify key languages and personality words in conversation.(3 minutes)
- Each group is asked to make their own dialog which contains personality and present it in front of the class.
  (8 minutes)
- Each group is given some papers which have been written a word in each paper, containing personality vocabulary. (1 minutes)
- Members of each group are asked to write a statement individually then compare.(5 minutes)
- Students listen to the Practices 1 and 2 then practice in pair. (5 minutes)
  - c. **Post-activity**: (5 minutes)
- Students are checked their understanding by having a chit chat with the teacher. (3 minutes)
- Students are asked to share their feeling about the material whether it's hard or not. (2 minutes)
- 9. **Assessment/Evaluation**: The evaluation is done orally by having a conversation with each student.
- 10. **Homework:** The students are asked to write some sentences about family, relatives or friends and complete their workbooks.
